Summary: 911 system must have capability to answer calls in Spanish

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 23-47-35 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT EACH LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR JURISDICTION IN THIS STATE OPERATING AN EMERGENCY "911" SYSTEM MUST HAVE THE CAPABILITY OF ANSWERING CALLS IN SPANISH WITH THE SAME RESPONSE TIME AS CALLS ANSWERED IN ENGLISH.
