Summary: Murder

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 16-3-20, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO MURDER, SO AS TO ADD AS AN AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCE FOR WHICH THE DEATH PENALTY MAY BE IMPOSED FOR THE MURDER OF A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIAL DURING OR BECAUSE OF THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES AND INCLUDE A REFERENCE TO THIS AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCLUDING FAMILY MEMBERS IN THE PURVIEW OF THE STATUTE.
