H 3501 Concurrent Resolution, By R.A. Barber, J.J. Bailey, Cato, R.C. Fulmer, Haskins, D.N. Holt, M.F. Jaskwhich, Keegan, Quinn and D.A. Wright

A Concurrent Resolution petitioning the Congress of the United States to propose an amendment to the United States Constitution for submission to the states to limit the number of terms a person may serve in the United States House of Representatives to no greater than six and to limit the number of terms a person may serve in the United States Senate to no greater than two, or in the alternative, to call a convention for the sole and exclusive purpose of proposing such an amendment for submission to the states for ratification.
