H 3672 General Bill, By Simrill, Kirsh, Meacham and Stille

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-101-196 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE PRESIDENT OF ANY STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING MAY NOT EARN ADDITIONAL INCOME OR CONSULTING FEES FROM ANY OTHER PUBLIC SOURCE IN AN AMOUNT EXCEEDING TEN PERCENT OF HIS COMPENSATION AS PRESIDENT AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, AND TO REQUIRE EARNED INCOME AND CONSULTING FEES FROM PRIVATE SOURCES TO BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THAT INSTITUTION AND THE STATE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD.
