H*3748 (Rat #0520, Act #0443 of 1980) General Bill, By J.C. Hearn, J.N. Ashe, T.M. Burriss, V.L. Crocker, H.C. Granger and J.E. Kinard

A Bill to amend Section 41-15-320, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to penalties for violation of Occupational Health and Safety Standards, so as to provide the Commissioner of Labor or his agents discretion in determining whether to assess a civil penalty for a serious violation of standards or regulations and discretion in determining whether to assess a civil penalty for a violation of the posting requirements.
