A Bill to amend Section 56-1-30, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to persons exempt from drivers' licensing requirements, so as to provide that a citizen of France who is at least eighteen years of age, who is employed in South Carolina, and who has a valid driver's license issued by that nation may drive in this State for four years.-amended title
