A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 13, ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO JUDICIAL CIRCUITS, SO AS TO REQUIRE THAT A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE BE AN ELECTOR OF THE COUNTY AND A RESIDENT OF HIS CIRCUIT FOR ONE YEAR PRECEDING HIS ELECTION.
