Summary: Employee of the state may not serve on the board or commission of agency employing him

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 8-13-735, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST PARTICIPATION IN DECISIONS AFFECTING A PERSON'S ECONOMIC INTEREST BY A PERSON WHO IS EMPLOYED BY OR SERVES ON THE GOVERNING BODY OF A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE MAY NOT SERVE ON THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE AGENCY EMPLOYING HIM OR ON ANY OTHER STATE BOARD OR COMMISSION WHICH REGULATES AN INDUSTRY WITH WHICH THE EMPLOYEE IS INVOLVED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES.
