H*4004 (Rat #0744, Act #0636 of 1988) General Bill, By Wilkins, T.E. Huff and J.T. McElveen

A Bill to amend Section 20-7-755, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the conduct of family court hearings involving children, so as to provide for the hearings to be conducted in a formal instead of informal manner and delete the provision requiring a transcript of the hearings if the court orders it.
