A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-36-2130, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM THE USE TAX, SO AS TO EXEMPT A TOTAL OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS OF SALES PRICE IN A CALENDAR YEAR FOR OTHERWISE TAXABLE SALES TO AN INDIVIDUAL FOR PERSONAL USE AND NOT INCLUDING ANY ITEM FOR CONSUMPTION OR USE IN A TRADE OR BUSINESS.
