Summary: Motor fuel user fees

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-28-1730, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CIVIL PENALTIES APPLICABLE WITH RESPECT TO VIOLATIONS ARISING PURSUANT TO THE USER FEE ON MOTOR FUELS, SO AS TO DELETE THE MINIMUM ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR CIVIL PENALTY AND LIMIT TO A TOTAL OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS THE TEN DOLLARS A GALLON CIVIL PENALTY THAT MAY BE IMPOSED ON A VEHICLE OPERATOR FOR THE UNLAWFUL USE OF DYED FUEL IN ANY ONE VEHICLE OR FOR THE STORAGE OF DYED MOTOR FUEL FOR UNLAWFUL USE IN ANY ONE STORAGE TANK.
