A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 3, TITLE 27, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE LIMITATION ON LIABILITY FOR LANDOWNERS TO ENCOURAGE THEM TO MAKE THEIR PROPERTY AVAILABLE FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES, SO AS TO PROVIDE A MORE COMPLETE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "PERSON"; TO PROVIDE THAT THE LANDOWNER MAY, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, PERMIT THE USE OF HIS LAND FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES; AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE LANDOWNER DOES NOT INCUR LIABILITY FOR AN INJURY CAUSED BY A NATURAL OR ARTIFICIAL CONDITION, STRUCTURE, OR PERSONAL PROPERTY ON THE PREMISES.
