Summary: Sex offender registry

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 23-3-430, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CONVICTIONS THAT RENDER A PERSON AS A SEX OFFENDER, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON CONVICTED OF A CRIME IN WHICH HE USED A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ON THE CRIME VICTIM DURING THE COMMISSION OF THE CRIME MUST REGISTER AS A SEX OFFENDER; AND TO AMEND SECTION 23-3-470, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH FAILING TO REGISTER AS A SEX OFFENDER, SO AS TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR FIRST AND SECOND OFFENSE FAILURE TO REGISTER AS A SEX OFFENDER.
