A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-2111, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO RESTRICTIONS PLACED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES WHEN IT ISSUES A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A COMMERCIAL SPECIAL LICENSE OR PERMIT WHICH INCLUDES A PROVISIONAL, ROUTE RESTRICTED HARDSHIP, OR TEMPORARY LICENSE THAT PERMITS A PERSON TO DRIVE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE DURING CERTAIN PERIODS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE ANY OF THESE FORMS OF LICENSES TO A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED AT LEAST TWO TIMES OF DRIVING A VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS, OR ANOTHER ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE.
