H*4505 (Rat #0436, Act #0377 of 1992) General Bill, By House Labor, Commerce and Industry

A Bill to amend Section 41-15-220, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the promulgation of regulations by the Department of Labor, so as to exempt occupational safety and health standards promulgated by the Department from the requirements of the Administrative Procedures Act and provide for notice after promulgation in the State Register and rebuttable presumptions regarding publication of notice.-amended title
