A Bill to amend Section 4-9-145, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to a county's authority to appoint and commission enforcement officers, so as to specify that these officers shall be code enforcement officers with the power of constables except that they may not perform custodial arrests, and to delete certain references to conflicts with the functions and duties of the sheriff's department in regard to the duties of these code enforcement officers.-amended title
