Summary: Sine die adjournment, General Assembly to meet for ninety days, adjourn sine die on ninetieth day; Citizen's Day A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 2-1-180, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE MANDATORY SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT DATE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AFTER CONVENING OF THE ANNUAL SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL MEET IN REGULAR SESSION ONLY FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY CONSECUTIVE CALENDAR DAYS, SHALL ADJOURN SINE DIE NOT LATER THAN 5:00 P.M. ON THE NINETIETH DAY, TO DELETE THE PROVISIONS WHICH AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO EXTEND THE SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT DATE, AND TO DESIGNATE EACH WEDNESDAY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS IN SESSION AS CITIZENS' DAY AT WHICH TIME THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL MEET AT 7:00 P.M.
