H 4985 General Bill, By Edge

Summary: Administrative Law Court

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 1-23-600, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO HEARINGS AND PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW COURT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A REQUEST FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING MAY BE FILED NINE MONTHS AFTER AN APPLICATION HAS BEEN FILED WITH AN AGENCY FOR A LICENSE OR PERMIT IF THE AGENCY HAS NOT MADE A DETERMINATION, TO PROVIDE FOR PROCEDURES TO GRANT THE AGENCY AN EXTENSION TO ISSUE A TERMINATION, AND TO PROVIDE A TIME FRAME FOR COMPLETION OF DISCOVERY AND FOR THE CONTESTED CASE HEARING IN CONTESTED CASES INVOLVING THE CERTIFICATE OF NEED PROCESS.
