### **S\*0532 (Rat #0340, Act #0317 of 2004) Joint Resolution, By Senate Judiciary**

**Summary:** Constitutional amendment; to authorize General Assembly to regulate sale of alcoholic beverages in containers deemed appropriated

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1, ARTICLE VIII-A OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO THE POWERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY PERTAINING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS AND BEVERAGES, SO AS TO REGULATE THEIR SALE IN CONTAINERS OF SUCH SIZE AS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE. - ratified title
