A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-220, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS, SO AS TO EXEMPT FROM PROPERTY TAX THE DWELLING OF THE OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A PERSON, WHO BUT FOR THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS, WOULD HAVE BEEN ELIGIBLE FOR THE DWELLING EXEMPTION ALLOWED CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS, AND ALLOWED THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF SUCH PERSON WHO DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY, AND ALLOWED PARAPLEGICS AND HEMIPLEGICS.
