S 0086 General Bill, By Thomas, Elliott, Ryberg and Reese

Summary: Motor vehicle property taxes, prorated refund provided when title transfer; Taxation, Motor Vehicles

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-2725, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PRORATED REFUND OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES ON A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN THE TITLE TO THE VEHICLE IS TRANSFERRED OR THE VEHICLE IS REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE, SO AS TO AUTHORIZE A PRORATED REFUND OF TAXES FOR THE PERIOD BETWEEN THE TRANSFER OF THE VEHICLE TITLE AND THE TRANSFERRING OF THE LICENSE PLATE TO ANOTHER VEHICLE, TO REQUIRE THIS PERIOD TO BE AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS BEFORE ANY REFUND IS DUE, TO PROVIDE THE METHOD OF CLAIMING THE REFUND, AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENTS OF REVENUE AND PUBLIC SAFETY JOINTLY TO PRESCRIBE THE APPROPRIATE FORM AND METHODS OF PROVING ELIGIBILITY.
