Summary: Failure to stop for a law enforcement officer

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-750, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO FAILING TO STOP A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN SIGNALLED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THIS PROVISION ALSO APPLIES TO A PERSON WALKING ALONG A ROAD, STREET, OR HIGHWAY, OR ANY OTHER FORM OF TRANSPORTATION TRAVELING ALONG A ROAD, STREET, OR HIGHWAY, TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR A FIRST OFFENSE WHERE NO GREAT BODILY INJURY OR DEATH RESULTED FROM THE VIOLATION, AND TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT PROVIDES THAT A PERSON'S RECORD OF ARREST AND CONVICTION MAY BE EXPUNGED.
