Summary: Firefighters

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 40-80-25 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AFTER JUNE 30, 2006, A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF ARSON MUST NOT PERFORM FIREFIGHTING DUTIES IN THIS STATE UNLESS THE PERSON IS EMPLOYED AS OF JUNE 30, 2006, AS A FIREFIGHTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW IN EFFECT AT THAT TIME AND TO FURTHER PROVIDE THAT IF THE PERSON LEAVES THIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, THE PROHIBITION APPLIES.
