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#### AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

In FY 2023-2024, the State Fiscal Accountability Authority ("SFAA" or the "Agency") the State Fiscal Accountability Authority ("SFAA" or the "Agency") consistently worked to fulfill the Agency's mission of providing fiscal oversight for the State of South Carolina and meeting the needs of the public sector by delivering quality, cost-effective insurance, procurement, and engineering services. The accomplishments reflected in this Report demonstrate the hard work and commitment to excellence of SFAA's staff and leadership.

Established by the Restructuring Act of 2014, Act 121, SFAA is comprised of the Insurance Reserve Fund Division and the Division of Procurement Services. The Agency is governed by a five-member Authority consisting of: the Governor, the Treasurer, the Comptroller General, the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, and the Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, all of whom serve ex-officio. Administrative and operational functions of the Agency are led by Executive Director Grant Gillespie.

#### Major Achievements During Fiscal Year 2023-2024

#### **Division of Procurement Services (DPS)**

The Division of Procurement Services (DPS) includes four operational sections — Office of State Procurement (OSP), Office of the State Engineer (OSE), Audit and Certification, and Business Operations and Strategic Planning. Some accomplishments achieved by these offices in FY 2023-2024 include the following:

#### 1. Office of State Procurement (OSP)

#### A. Contract Management and Assistance

• The contract results provided by OSP in FY 2023-2024 are as follows:

- OSP established new State Term Contracts for Protective Equipment & Supplies, Detention Supplies, Traffic Control Devices, High Intensity Tutoring Services, Proofpoint compliance and cybersecurity solutions, Cradlepoint routers, gateways, software for wireless networking, to name a few.
- The State realized contractual savings due to strategies designed to reduce the budgetary impacts for state agencies and local governments allowing for greater return on investment.

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The State realized the following savings through cost avoidance strategies and negotiated savings:

• In addition to the savings listed above, OSP also provided reverse auction services

to agencies to drive down pricing in certain commodities which resulted in annual savings of \$12.4 million.

OSP collaborated with agencies and institutions of higher education to establish critical contracts, some of which include: Sumter Veteran's Home Operations – Department of Veteran's Affairs; Quality Assurance Services for Electronic Titling & Registering of Vehicles – SCDMV; Electronic Health Records – SCDMH; Evacuation Transport Management – Adjutant General's Office/SCEMD; Dining Services for The Citadel and Lander University; Cellphone Interdiction Services – SCDC; Child Support Services Call Center – DSS; South Carolina Tobacco Quitline – SCDHEC; Food administration full service – SCDC; Enterprise Resource Planning System – Clemson University; Production Equipment Refresh – SCETV; and, Bride Asset Management – SCDOT.

#### **B.** Training and Outreach

• The Office of State Procurement planned and conducted a 31 Instructor led procurement training courses and 9 webinars for 213 trainees in FY2023-2024.

#### 2. Office of State Engineer (OSE)

OSE's primary role is to assist state agencies in acquiring construction services in the manner best suited to the agency's needs. OSE is responsible to assure that all such acquisitions comply with state law. The State Engineer, as the Building Official and Deputy State Fire Marshal for construction of state buildings and facilities, is responsible for enforcement of all applicable building and fire codes. In addition, OSE serves as the administrator of the State-level Floodplain Management Program for State lands.

• In FY 2023-2024, OSE provided the following services:

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- OSE increased the number of active agencies utilizing a new database for completing and tracking professional services and construction forms. As of June 2024, approximately 100% of active agencies have been trained and can access the database.
- In August 2023, OSE and the Statewide Contracts team implemented a two-year pilot program for 7 agencies to utilize the Job Order Contracting construction delivery method in accordance with Proviso 117.167. As of July 1, 2024, all seven agencies have been utilizing the program and reviews of the delivery method appear to be favorable.
- OSE assisted agencies during the design of state facilities. Several of the largest include Clemson University's Veterinary School (\$270M), USC School of Medicine (\$300M), Clemson University's Williamson Rd Parking Garage (\$70M), and SC State University's Turner Hall (\$70M).
- OSE assisted agencies during the construction of state facilities. Several of the largest include the new Dept. of Public Health/Environmental Services Lab (\$150M), Clemson University's Jervey Athletic Center (\$50M), and Clemson University's Bryan Mall Renovation (\$53 M).

#### 3. Audit and Certification

Audit and Certification is responsible for conducting periodic audits of each agency's procurement operations to determine compliance with the South Carolina Procurement Code and regulations.

- A. Audit status: Conducted audits and published reports of six certified agencies, two follow-ups, and one Certification of two newly created agencies from the dissolution of one.
- B. School Districts Procurement Codes: Approved 16 alternate procurement codes based on the School District Model Code.

#### 4. SCPro eProcurement

Continued managing the implementation of SCPro in collaboration with the SC Department of Administration and SCEIS. SCPro is the new web-based eProcurement system that will result in greater procurement purchasing efficiencies statewide and will improve access to business opportunities by suppliers and small businesses. SCPro will include a virtual marketplace that consists of online supplier catalogs which state agencies, local governments and political subdivisions can access to purchase goods and services electronically.

#### Insurance Reserve Fund Division (IRF)

The Insurance Reserve Fund (IRF) is a self-insurance mechanism operated by the State of South Carolina providing insurance to governmental entities at the lowest possible cost. All State agencies must purchase their insurance through the IRF and participation is optional for local governments. The Mission of the IRF is to provide property and liability insurance products that meet the needs of its governmental customers in a financially secure and responsible manner. The Insurance Reserve Fund currently insures more than \$40 billion in property values for State and local government entities. Some accomplishments achieved by the IRF in FY 2023-2024 include the following:

#### 1. Effectively managed claims and losses relating to catastrophic events

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- Finalized all first party loss payments from IRF to its insureds related to the December 2022 Winter Storm Elliott; sought and received full reimbursement from the reinsurance markets. The total amount of losses IRF paid its insureds was \$13,547,316.
- Responded to 5 Mini Catastrophe Claims:
  - ▶ Flood Event– December 17, 2023, estimated losses: \$3.69 million and 11 claims
  - Storm Event– January 9, 2024, estimated losses: \$1.4 million and 19 claims
  - Freeze Event– January 20-21, 2024, estimated losses: \$609 thousand and 10 claims
  - ▶ Hailstorm Event– April 20, 2024, estimated losses: \$3.98 million and 11 claims
  - ▶ Hailstorm Event– May 10, 2024, estimated losses: \$201 thousand and 2 claims

#### 2. Developed Risk Management Strategy for Water Damage Losses

- Analyzed property trend data and determined that in recent years, apart from natural catastrophe losses, interior originating water damage has been the single greatest cause of property loss for IRF.
- Developed and implemented a plan to minimize the damages which included issuing a risk control bulletin addressing "Interior-Originating Water Losses," scheduling risk control meetings with insureds with the largest losses, providing a safety engineer to present risk management techniques and available technology, and making strategic recommendations to insureds with large property holdings and large losses.

#### 3. Renewed Property Reinsurance Coverage

- IRF successfully purchased reinsurance for a capacity level to protect for an 80-year storm and maintained the existing occurrence self-inured retention (SIR). This renewal of reinsurance coverage was, in part, due to:
  - Continued improvement in the quantity and quality of data points collected and reported in IRF Statement of Values;
  - Ongoing building valuation and appraisal work, which validated the increase in values made during the 2023 trending project was appropriate to keep pace with inflation;
  - The property reinsurance markets' positive view of the IRF claims handling of past catastrophic events and consistent reservice practices.

#### 4. Provided training and outreach to enhance State's Risk Management Practices

- Conducted virtual Underwriting seminar and Renewal Refresher workshop for 160 attendees. This seminar focused on how policyholders can complete renewal worksheets and evaluate the need for additional coverages.
- Hosted Medical Professional Risk Management seminars directed to hospitals on the following topics: "Artificial Intelligence, Current Liability Issues, Workplace Violence, EMTALA, and ADA" in Charleston, SC and "Legislative updates and Current Trends in SC Court Cases" in Columbia.

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• Successfully hosted annual meetings for specialty lines insurance – Ocean Marine insurance, Aviation insurance, and UAV/Drone insurance – and the insureds to discuss terms of renewal, state of the market, unique issues of coverage, and other educational opportunities.

#### 5. Received a favorable Statutory Examination Report

of the IRF covering the fiscal years of 2021, 2022, and 2023. The Department of Insurance reported that the IRF is being administered in accordance with sound insurance practices and in the best interest of the State of South Carolina. There were no negative findings.

#### Agency Wide

#### 1. Management of activity related to the five-member Authority

#### A. Authority Meeting and Agenda Process

The Authority held 7 meetings during the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. Prior to each meeting, SFAA staff and the Executive Director held agenda review meetings with internal and external staff and others as needed to develop the meeting agenda and address any matters prior to the meeting.

#### **B.** Coordination with Authority Members

The Agency responded promptly to our members' offices about pending and potential agenda items, such as procurement audits, major leases, composite bank accounts, and management and assignment of bond counsel.

#### 2. Administration of the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund (SCORF) Board A. SCORF Board Meetings and Opioid Fund Distribution

- Managed the administration of the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board. The SCORF Board held six in person meetings, two virtual meetings and provided virtual viewing capabilities of meetings for members of the public.
- The SCORF Board awarded approximately \$11,580,107.05 to 34 counties, towns and cities that requested funds to help combat the opioid epidemic. The Board awarded twenty-one entities discretionary funding in the amount of \$7,421,013.54 for efforts to address the opioid crisis.

#### B. Enhancements for Transparency and Technical Assistance

- Continue to update the SCORF website which provides critical and timely information about the SCORF Board, the processes for allowing the entities to apply for the funds and the technical requirements for applicants, opioid fund uses, allocation amounts, SCORF Board meeting minutes and agendas, accountability and reporting information, and links to helpful references.
- In 2023, the SCORF Board Staff began hosting a monthly 'Coffee Chat'— a virtual meeting for the public on the first Friday of each month with announcements and a variety of educational presentations.

#### 3. Assistance to Agency Head Salary Commission

• SFAA continued to provide staffing support and administrative functions for the Agency Head Salary Commission.

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- Prepared agenda items and supporting materials for the Commissions meetings. Based on market trends and statewide salary data, made recommendations to the Commission regarding agency heads hiring salaries, salary increases, performance evaluations and salary ranges.
- 4. Strengthened operations through process improvements, cost-saving measures, and compliance with applicable laws.
  - SFAA IT redesigned the SFAA Agency website which allows the Authority Board Authority Secretary to schedule meetings and track attendance of participants by offering a registration page and form on the SFAA/ Authority Board page that is managed by the OED staff and Authority Secretary.
  - SFAA HR monitors the number of employees who complete career development related training each year to ensure that skills across the agency are continuously enhanced. Sixty-five percent of SFAA employees participated in some level of career development training in FY24.

#### 5. Implemented Strategic Planning Initiatives

#### A. Conducted Regular Management Meetings

- The Senior Management team met on a bi-weekly basis to determine progress toward Agency goals and objectives. These meetings focus on challenges from all agency divisions and offices, major project updates, and legislative matters that impact our delivery of services to our customers and the citizens of the State of South Carolina.
- Held the annual Management Retreat which focused on leadership strategies for managing changes and applying effective leadership principles.

#### **Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies**

A. Provide innovative, cost effective and proactive acquisition services (Strategic Plan Goal No. 5)

#### Potential Most Negative Impact if this goal is not accomplished:

The State should expect to pay more for goods and services, as there would be no coordinated program dedicated to lowering costs by leveraging the State's collective buying power. Without such a program, statewide contracts would not be awarded which would result in increased administrative costs. The lack of any centralized procurement office would result in: a) increased cost to vendors due to an uncoordinated approach to procurement across multiple agencies; b) increased risk of poor performance and contract claims due to a lack of statewide training and support efforts; and c) decreased transparency and accountability across the State's acquisition system.

<u>Outside Help to Mitigate Impact Request and options for General Assembly</u>: assistance from procurement trade groups, interstate networks and professional consulting firms. Continued support and resources for a robust and automated procurement system.

B. Provide cost-effective property and liability insurance and administration of the Insurance Reserve Fund (Strategic Plan Goal No. 2)

#### Potential Most Negative Impact if this goal is not accomplished:

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If the IRF did not operate, the State should expect to pay more to insure against its risks, with some agencies likely having difficulty obtaining coverage from a private insurance carrier because of poor loos experience and the nature of the risks involved, such as law enforcement, corrections and transportation. Also, absent the stability of IRF rates, the State should expect significant swings in premium costs due to normal cyclical changes in the commercial insurance market.

<u>Outside Help to Mitigate Impact Request and options for General Assembly</u>: IRF undergoes regular audits and actuarial evaluations. Risks to these programs could be avoided through continued oversight, proper funding and support for existing improvement efforts.


