Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill amends Section 43-25-70, which relates to concession stands that are operated by the Commission for the Blind and provides that an operator of a concession stand may not subcontract the installation or operation of the concession stand to a person who is not blind or does not have a severe visual disability.

Commission for the Blind. The department indicates that the bill may require three vendors to eliminate subcontractors who are not blind or do not have a severe visual disability. However, the bill would have no expenditure impact.
