Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will increase non-recurring General Fund expenses for the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) by \$5,000. This bill will have no expenditure impact on Other Funds or Federal Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 10, 2017

State Expenditure

This bill requires a person whose driver's license has been suspended upon conviction of a motor vehicle moving violation to successfully complete the National Safety Council's Defensive Driving Course or its equivalent before the privilege to operate a motor vehicle is reinstated. The course must be taught by an instructor approved by DMV. DMV indicates that non-recurring General Fund expenses associated with this bill will total \$5,000 for programing and testing.
