Fiscal Impact Summary

The Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) is working to provide an estimated expenditure impact for these additional responsibilities regarding the awareness and mitigation of the health and well-being impact of adverse childhood experiences. Therefore, the expenditure impact of this bill is pending, contingent upon a response from DHEC.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 8, 2019

State Expenditure

This bill requires DHEC to allocate sufficient state, federal, and private grant funding to raise awareness of adverse childhood experiences (ACEs). DHEC shall implement strategies to reduce the occurrence of ACEs and mitigate their impact on the health and well-being of residents. DHEC may contract with an external organization to ensure successful completion of the required oversight. Annually, DHEC shall report to the General Assembly, on the state of ACEs in South Carolina and existing and needed resources to mitigate the effects of ACEs.

DHEC is working to provide an estimated expenditure impact for these additional responsibilities. Therefore, the expenditure impact of this bill is pending, contingent upon a response from DHEC.
