## **Introduced on January 12, 2021 State Expenditure**

This bill requires DHEC to promulgate regulations that integrate midwives into the organization of perinatal levels of care. DHEC is responsible for the licensure and oversight of hospital facilities as well as midwives. DHEC indicates that implementation and enforcement of this bill will be conducted using existing staff and resources. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the agency.
