Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill specifies that Legislative Council and the Code Commissioner have determined that Volume 13A of the Code of Laws is appropriate for revision. The bill provides approval from the General Assembly for the revised Volume 13A containing Title 39, S.C. Code of Laws. Revising the Code of Laws is in the normal course of business for Legislative Council and will be accomplished with existing staff and resources. Therefore, the bill is not expected to impact expenditures.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 18, 2023

State Expenditure

Section 2-13-90 authorizes the Legislative Council and the Code Commissioner to contract to be prepared and published under their supervision and direction revised volumes of the Code of Laws. The Legislative Council and the Code Commissioner have determined that Volume 13A is appropriate for revision. Section 2-13-90 of the S.C. Code also provides that the revised volumes must be submitted to the General Assembly for its consideration.

The bill provides approval from the General Assembly for the revised Volume 13A. Revising the Code of Laws is in the normal course of business for Legislative Council and will be accomplished with existing staff and resources. Therefore, the bill is not expected to impact expenditures.
