**Fiscal Impact Summary**

This joint resolution requires the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) to review the current law regarding Alzheimer’s special care units in community residential care facilities. The portion of DHEC that involves public health will become the Department of Public Health (DPH) on July 1, 2024. DHEC must provide a report to the General Assembly by January 1, 2025, with recommendations for changes and improvements to the current law. There is no expenditure impact to DHEC or DPH since DHEC anticipates that the responsibilities of the resolution can be managed with existing agency staff and resources.
